Fresh from their performances at Blues at Bridgetown last month Home Brew is set to get the South West Blues Club Jumping for this years Christmas party. The band has a huge following in the south west and in particular at the blues club where they have been the house band for over three years. On the back of their successful eastern states appearances and launch of their original CD “Cynical Swing” the band has developed a unique and distinctive blues style, characterised by a driving rhythm and soaring guitar punctuated by unison playing of the sax and harmonica to give an almost brass section quality to the sound.

In 2006 they became the resident band for the South West Blues Club which enabled the band to extend its professionalism and musicianship by backing national and international artists such as Louisiana Blues’ man Eugene Hideaway Bridges, Queen of the Boogie Woogie Piano, Jan Preston and Australian Multi award winner Andy Cowan who said “the boys from “Home Brew” did an awesome job”. Bass player Carl Holroyd said that “backing professional musicians such as the ones mentioned has enabled the band to grow as players and enabled the band to encounter a variety of styles which will be reflected on Friday night. Special guests will be joining Home Brew on the night to provide club patrons with a night of danceable music.
